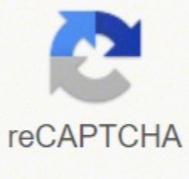

Can is used to express ability or permission. It is often used in informal contexts.



Examples:

- Must:** You must wear your seat belt. I must finish this report by tomorrow.
- Can:** I can speak three languages. You can borrow my book if you like.

- Giraffes** reach high into trees to eat the leaves.
- Camels** go without food or water for a long time.
- Penguins** live in the ice and snow.
- Snakes** walk or run.
- Kangaroos** jump high, but they walk backwards.
